The Bronze Basic Remodel includes: Based on a standard 40 sq./ft. bathroom or smaller

- Complete removal and replacement of existing 3-piece bathroom.
- New tub or pre-fab shower base.
- Insulate exterior walls and ceiling.
- Install moisture-resistant sheetrock and cement board in wet areas (3 coats of joint compound and sand).
- Tile shower/tub walls with two corner shelves
- Level the sub floor and install floor tile.
- Prime and paint (Benjamin Moore paints)
- Install vent fan, light fixture over the sink, and GFI receptacle
- Replace shut-off valves, drain lines, and waterlines (excludes diverters and rain shower heads)
- Allowances for vanity/sink, toilet, shower fixtures, faucet, hardware, mirror/medicine cabinet, tile & grout, shower rod
- Full cleaning upon completion

Bronze Package Exclusions:

- Shower glass doors/ sliders
- Entry door to the bathroom
- Windows
- HVAC work
- Niche or recessed med cabinets

The Silver Mid-Level Remodel includes: Based on a 40-60 sq./ft. bathroom or smaller

- Replace plumbing fixtures or relocate sink
- Install new tub or pre-fab shower base
- Add insulation to exterior walls/ceiling
- Install moisture-resistant sheetrock and cement board in wet areas (3 coats joint compound and sand).
- Tile shower/tub walls and half height of outer shower walls; include 15x20 recessed niche
- Frame for recessed medicine cabinet
- Level subfloor and install floor tile
- Prime and paint (Benjamin Moore paints)
- Install vent fan, 1 sink light, 1 six-inch LED light, and 1
 GFI receptacle
- Replace shut-off valves, drain line, and waterlines; up to 3' baseboard radiator swap; plumbing for handheld shower head
- Include allowances for all finishes (sink, toilet, shower trim, faucet, hardware, mirror/cabinet, tile, shower rod)
- Full cleaning upon completion

Silver Package Exclusions:

- Shower glass doors/ sliders
- Entry door to bathroom
- Windows
- HVAC work

Moving walls or reconfiguring the space will add to the overall cost.


Unknown Damages
